Mr. Lauritzen has served as the Director General for the Danish Enterprise and Construction Authority (DECA) since June 2006. DECA is a part of the Ministry of Economics and Business Affairs, and the Authority has several fields of responsibility, including: enterprise, construction, housing, regional and international trade policies. Before working at DECA, Mr. Lauritzen was Director General for the Danish Competition Authority (between 1997-2006). From 2004 to 2006, he was Deputy Chairman in OECD's Competition Committee.
